WHAT IS ROTARY

- ◆ Rotary International is the world's first service club organization, with more than 1.2 million members in 33,000 clubs worldwide.
- ◆ Rotary club members are volunteers who work locally, regionally, and internationally to combat hunger, improve health and sanitation, provide education and job training, promote peace, and eradicate polio. under the motto Service Above Self.
- ◆ Scottsville Rotary meets the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month for fellowship and interesting and informational programs dealing with topics of local and global importance. Membership reflects a wide cross section of community representation.
- ◆ Rotarians plan and carry out a remarkable variety of humanitarian, educational, and cultural exchange programs that touch people's lives in their local communities and our world community.
- ◆ Rotary is The Rotary Foundation, which each year provides close to \$90 million for international scholarships, cultural exchanges, and humanitarian projects large and small that improve the quality of life for millions of people. Rotary is widely regarded as the world's largest private provider of international educational scholarships.
- ◆ The PolioPlus Program is the volunteer arm of the global partnership dedicated to eradicating polio. As long as polio threatens even one child anywhere in the world, children everywhere remain at risk. The stakes are that high.

Fourth: The advancement of international understanding, good will, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.
