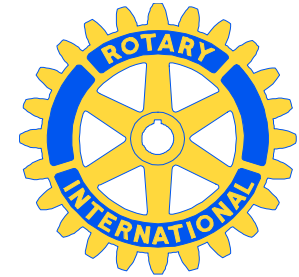

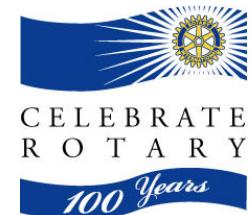

WHAT IS ROTARY

- ◆ Rotary is an organization of business and professional leaders united worldwide, who provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations, and help build goodwill and peace in the world.
- ◆ Rotary is the world's first service club. The first Rotary Club was founded in Chicago on February 23, 1905.
- ◆ There are 1.2 million service-minded women and men belonging to more than 29,000 Rotary clubs in 161 nations in the world.
- ◆ Rotarians meet weekly for fellowship and interesting and informational programs dealing with topics of local and global importance. Membership reflects a wide cross section of community representation.
- ◆ Rotarians plan and carry out a remarkable variety of humanitarian, educational, and cultural exchange programs that touch people's lives in their local communities and our world community.
- ◆ Rotary is The Rotary Foundation, which each year provides close to \$90 million for international scholarships, cultural exchanges, and humanitarian projects large and small that improve the quality of life for millions of people. Rotary is widely regarded as the world's largest private provider of international educational scholarships.

OBJECT OF ROTARY

The object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

First: The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service.

Second: High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations, and the dignifying by each Rotarian of his occupation as an opportunity to serve society.

Third: The application of the ideal of service by every Rotarian to his personal, business, and community life.

Fourth: The advancement of international understanding, good will, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.
